What Is Variable Data Printing?

Variable Data Printing (VDP) is a form of digital printing in which elements such as text, graphics, and images can be changed from one printed piece to the next using key data points to create a personal experience for the recipient.

How Does Variable Data Printing Work?

1.) Collect your data, sources may include:

Demographics, Social Presence, Purchase History, Browsing History

2.) Create a design and determine variable elements:

3.) Create a spreadsheet of key data points as they relate to the design:

4.) Premier will integrate your design files, spreadsheet, and placement of variable elements:
